

BORN OF FIRE

A turning point in the art of cymbal making occurred 384 years ago in 1623... A new process for creating beautiful musical instruments was born.

The elements of the traditional cymbal-bronze alloy are melted in deep pots covered with special lids made from mud and clay. They are heated with the finest quality coal, at around

1100-1200°C (2200 °F), for over an hour until the molten metal boils; then it is poured into cast iron moulds. As soon as the alloy has firmed, the casting are pulled from the moulds as flat, round discs.

These discs are heated in a wood-fired oven at around 600-700°C until they become red hot, and then repeatedly passed through the antique roller press until they achieve their desired thinness. The next step is shaping by hand or with another press to form the domed bell of the cymbal, before a hole is drilled into its center. The edges of the cymbal are now cut to a perfect circle and the discarded metal goes back into the melting pots.

The newly emerging cymbal is now placed on a steel anvil and beaten for 20-25 minutes with iron hammers to compress the metal and bend it into the right shape. The cymbal smiths stuff cotton wool into their ears to protect their hearing against the deafening ringing of the hammers.

In the next step of its transformation, the cymbal is attached to a spinning lathe. One lathe man, or "turner", remowers a thin layer of the cymbal's top surface with a long steel knife, creating the tonal groovers, then sends it on to a second turner who repeats the process on the underside of the cymbal.

The lathe men's work on the turning cymbals leaves tiny, curled strands of bronze all over the floor of the workshop. These strands also go back into the melting pot at the end of each day.

Next, the almost-finished cymbal is sent to the master turner who lathes both surfaces fully and smoothly. The cymbal is rubbed with a soft cloth to make certain it is smooth and shiny, and then finally, the cymbal smiths stamp it with factory name "Amedia." The Amedia cold stamp is each cymbal's mark of authenticity. The diameter of the cymbal is measured in inches and each cymbal graded by weight and thickness in various categories like "crash," "splash, "ride" and "hi-hat."

The finished product is rested for a few days, since the metal retains its heat for a long while, and the true sound of the cymbal only emerges after it has been throughly rested and cooled. Once the cymbals have rested, the master cymbal smith then plays each one as a quality control.

The fail ones are cut into pieces for the melting pot; only the ones that meet the master's rigorous sonic standard will ever leave the factory.

Named for master cymbal smith Ahmet Baykusak, the Ahmet line is Amedia's flagship.

Utmost care and exquisite craftsmanship characterize the Ahmets, preferred by jazz and funk players. Extensive hammering and some of the most beautiful lathing in the business by master latheman Hamdusana Baykusak make for cymbals that are dark, warm and full-bodied.

Generally thin or medium thin in weight, the Ahmets work well in both big band and small group settings.

The 21" crash-ride with two rivets, combined with the 19" crash-ride and 14" hi-hats is the most popular setup in this line.

Lathed paper thin by Hamdusana Baykusak, the Vintage cymbals open quickly when crashed then get right out of the way, while still providing clear stick definition for your intricate ride patterns. The rides' breathy wash is the perfect comp behind piano and reeds, while the hihats provide a satisfying, low-pitched chick.

The Vintage vibe is enhanced by lack of printed logos on the cymbals. Look for the Amedia cold-stamp to ensure you are buying an authentic Amedia Vintage.

The rides are strong with a great bounce and clear bell; the crashes pack a punch and hold lots of potential sound energy. Hi-hats are loud with a tight stick response.

Two extra steps in the creative process give the Antiques their unique sound and look.

After an initial hammering and sharp lathing, they are heavily supplemental-hammered by master hammersmiths Shaban and Ahmet Baykusak.

Then for their defining sound and finish, the Antiques are finally given one more pass through the wood-fired furnace.

The rides are low-pitched with a dry tight wash, the crashes earthy and explosive. Hi-hat pairs are heavy with an aggressive open wash and powerful chick.

After our meeting in our factory, we designed this model in 2008. Both sides of the cymbal are lathed and it has hammered bell. And also the edges of the bell and cymbal are extra lathed.

Amedia Cymbals are guaranteed against manufacturer's defects for one year from the date of original purchase.

For warranty claims outside the Turkey, contact your local Amedia distributor.

Warranty Process

Cymbals that show factory defects within one year of their original purchase are eligible for examination at our factory. The cymbals will be evaluated and you will be informed about the damage and replacement cymbal, unless it appears the damage is related to improper use or care.

The progress of the replacement request:

- 1. Take a picture of the damage on the cymbal.
- 2. Mark the location of the damage on the cymbal.
- 3. Make a photocopy of your original numbered and dated sales receipt.
- 4. Carefully package your cymbal. Include the photocopy of your sales receipt in the box. Also include a letter with your name and address on it. And write down what kind of cymbal you send to us (serie, type and measure).
 - 5. Ship the package to:


Unacceptable conditions to apply for replacement:

- 1. If it has been misplayed, dropped, played with excessive force or treated abusively.
 - 2. If the center hole is worn due to improper stand set-up or abusive play.
 - 3. If the cymbal was bought second-hand.
 - 4. If the cymbal has previously been replaced by Amedia.
- 5. If the crack starts from the outer edge and moves towards vertically to the bell of the cymbal.

Warranty Notes:

Cost of shipping a damaged cymbal to Amedia is the customers responsibility.

- Factory evaluations take approximately 4 6 weeks.
- Cymbals that do not meet the warranty guidelines can be returned to customer. Cost of shipping need to be covered by customer.
 Or customer can decide the cymbal does not need to be returned.
 - Cost of shipping a replacement within the warranty conditions to the customer will be covered by Amedia.
